- Counseling and aid for the victims of violence, including domestic violence, sexual violence, and sex trafficking
- Free legal and medical aid
- Counseling on visa extensions and the naturalization process
- Counseling on adapting to life in Korea and the protection of human and other rights
- Connection to relevant organizations including the Shelter for Migrant Woman Who Are Victims of Violence



- Accommodation and meals
- Counseling and medical aid

⟨Self-reliance subsidy system⟩

Self-reliance support system helps migrant women who are victims of violence to adapt to a community.

- Targets: Migrant women who endeavor to be independent after leaving shelters.
- Subsidy: Up to 5 Million KRW per person (to be decided based on an evaluation).

What is violence?

Domestic violence

Any acts resulting in physical, mental, or material damages among family members.

Sexual violence

Any acts resulting in physical, mental or social damages to other parties by forcing sexual behaviors on those parties without consent, or by forcing those parties to do sexual behaviors.

Sex Trafficking

Intercourses or similar acts to take money, valuables and other gains from many and unspecified persons, done by promising such gains.

In case of experiencing any damages due to violence, immediately ask for help without hesitation!



Domestic violence against migrant women



Physical violence

Any acts causing wounds or damages using physical power, including hitting the body of the other party



Verbal and emotional violence

Any acts causing emotional injuries to the other party verbally



Sexual violence

Any acts asking for sexual intercourses that the other party doesn't want or causes sexual humiliation



Economic violence

No living expenses are given or arbitrary acts of disposing of property without the consent of the other party.



Restriction

Any acts of hiding the ID of the other party, including passports, or blocking any relation -ship with others (blocking from attending Korean classes or a home-country club).



What can we do in case we experience damages due to violence?

Immediately call

Danuri Call Center 1577-1366 1366, the emergency helpline for women.

Counsel with the Migrant Women Counseling Center and ask for an interpreter.

Immediately

call 112 to report the violence to the police. Ask for help

from a friend, an acquaintance, or a neighbor.

Get a medical examination

in the case of any injuries and keep the medical examination record.

Prepare required personal possessions

including passports, alien registration cards, cash, simple clothing, and contact details.
